

SERVICES

Individuals battling substance use disorders associated with alcohol, drugs, tobacco use, gambling, and/or other addictions can find treatment and support at Meridian Health Services. Depending on the severity of the disorder or addiction, a number of treatment options are available, including:

- Psychiatric Evaluation
- Addictions and Recovery Center (ARC)
- Maternal Treatment Program (MTP)
- Home with Hope (HWH)
- Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOT)
- Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT)
- Medication Management
- Individual and Group Counseling
- Primary Medical Care through MeridianMD
- Peer Recovery Support
- Family Support
- Aftercare Services
- Support Groups

Addiction Services are provided by Meridian Health Services' staff who are trained and licensed.

Several Meridian Health Services locations throughout Indiana offer addiction services. The range of services available may vary by location.



RIVER BEND HOSPITAL

Meridian's adult psychiatric treatment program offers those who are struggling with mental health disorders

the ability to stabilize severe symptoms and to shift to less rigorous stages of mental health care.

River Bend Hospital's expert team treats the following illnesses:

- Severe depression
- Suicidal thoughts
- Psychosis
- Bipolar disorder
- Other serious mental illnesses



ADDICTIONS & RECOVERY CENTER

The Addictions and Recovery Center (ARC) provides more intensive treatment in a residential

setting. Clients receive 24-hour clinical care while in a residential, therapeutic environment, treated through "whole-person" health methods including behavioral therapy, intensive rehabilitation, wellness education, medical care, and post-treatment support. Residential treatment lasts up to 30 days.



HOME WITH HOPE

Located in Lafayette, Home With Hope offers a continuum of care, through our men's and women's recovery homes. We provide

treatment in an environment conducive to long-term recovery that will enable patients to re-enter their communities.



WOMEN'S RECOVERY HOME

Meridian Women's Recovery Home provides a solid foundation for women struggling

with substance use disorder and seeking recovery. Upon assessment, infants 3 months and younger may be considered for admission with mother.

The program consists of a structured, 2-Phase addiction and behavioral health treatment, with a holistic approach treating the mind and body in a residential group home setting for up to 90 days. Meridian Women's Recovery Home places a strong focus on integrated care for women and their children through additional services such as primary medical care, women's health, and pediatrics.



MATERNAL TREATMENT PROGRAM

The Maternal Treatment Program is an outpatient program that provides care to mothers with substance use disorder(s) and their children (under 5 years of age) dependent on substances. Offered in multiple locations across the state, the program is designed for "whole-person" health through prevention, education, treatment, and community support. This helps change the lifestyle of mothers in crisis, which in turn changes the outcome for a child born into addiction.



INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT AND AFTERCARE ADDICTION SERVICES

Addictions services are divided into two distinct phases to provide effective long-term treatment. First, an individual will participate in Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOT) focusing on addiction treatment that occurs a minimum of 9 hours per week. Following completion, an individual will participate in an 12 week relapse prevention program. This is a weekly group therapy program focused on long-term recovery.



Meridian Health Services helps promote long-term freedom from addictions through specialized programs for individuals who are dealing with substance use disorders and other addictions. These programs are designed to treat addiction and promote the change to a healthy lifestyle.

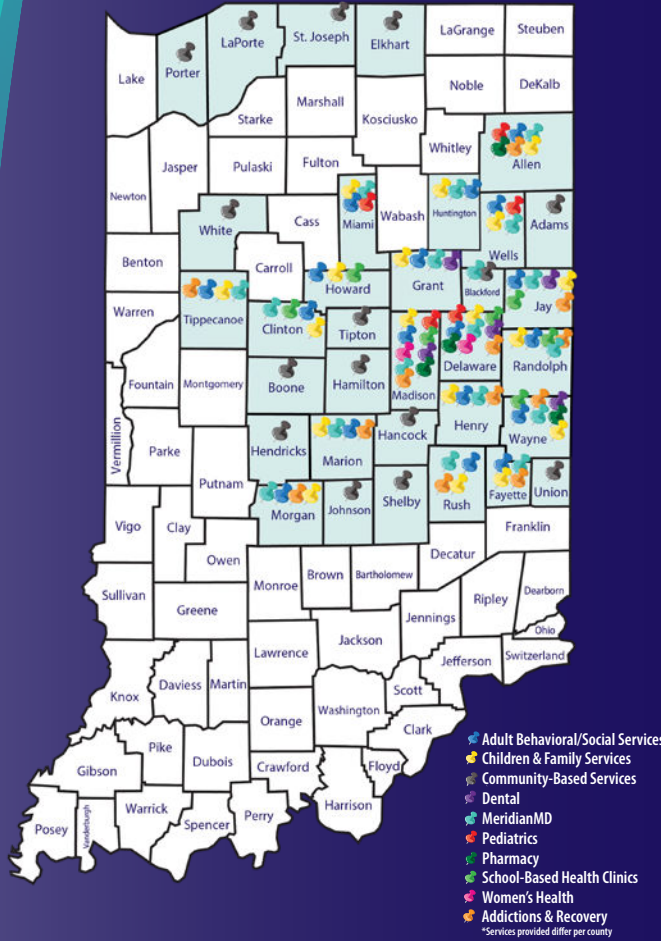
